

# Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (*because prices can vary*).

## Attended Funeral (Funeral Director's charges only)

£2755.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements. £725.00

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (*normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's Premises*) into the Funeral Director's care £260.00

Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities  
The deceased person will rest at both the funeral director's head office or branch office £565.00

Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from wood veneer with a teak stain £375.00

Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director. (*Where viewing is requested by the customer*) £440.00

At a date and time you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (*normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Director's premises*) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle £390.00

## Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (*Funeral Director's charges only*) £2115.00

Cremation (*Funeral Director's charges plus the cremation fee*)<sup>2</sup> £1425.00

## Fees you must pay

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee<sup>1</sup> £348 - £ 1375

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: £348 - £ 1375

(*For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees*)

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
